2. Eligibility criteria for admission to MD/MS/MDS/Diploma seats except MD (CHA) and DHE course

- i) The candidate must have passed final M.B.B.S. examination (for MD/MS Course) and final BDS examination (for MDS Course) from University of Delhi and must have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory rotating internship as on 31.03.2012 and must submit their internship completion certificate before or at the time of appearing for the counselling.
- ii) The candidate must have full registration with the Delhi Medical Council/ State Medical Council/ Medical Council of India/ Dental Council of India.
- iii) A candidate in order to become eligible for admission must obtain 50% marks in the AIPGMEE-2012. Provided that candidates belonging to SC and ST categories shall be required to obtain 40% marks in the AIPGMEE-2012 and in case of OBC candidates shall be required to obtain 45% marks in the AIPGMEE-2012.

3. Eligibility criteria for admission to MD (Community Health Administration) course

- i) A candidate must have completed satisfactorily one year of compulsory rotating internship after passing the final M.B.B.S. examination from University of Delhi or any other University / Institution recognised by MCI/UGC.
- ii) The candidate must have full registration with the Delhi Medical Council/ State Medical Council/ Medical Council of India.
- iii) The candidate must have put in 5 years of service on or before 31-03-2012.
- iv) The admission of the candidates will be made strictly according to merit based on the AIPGMEE – 2012.
- v) MD (CHA) seat will be filled up by Delhi University for 50% AIQ as well as 50% DU Quota based on the Merit of AIPGMEE - 2012

4. Eligibility criteria for admission to D.H.E. (Diploma in Health Education) course

The candidates seeking admission in DHE Course are not required to appear in AIPGMEE- 2012. The eligible candidates are required to apply to FMSc w.e.f. 29th December, 2011 to 21st January, 2012.

The candidates seeking admission to the above course shall satisfy the following conditions on or before 31-03-2012:

- (a) Bachelor's Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized by Medical Council of India with at least one year's experience of working in General Medicine/ Primary Health Centre/ Department of Preventive and Social Medicine or Community Health or in a Medical College. Preference will be given to those candidates who are in service.

OR

- (b) Master's Degree in selected Social Science (i.e. Psychology/ Sociology/ Anthropology/ Social Work/ Economics /Political Science/ Education) or Nursing from recognized University with at least one year's experience in community health welfare programmes or teaching in Social Biological Science/ Physical Education / Home Science. Preference will be given to those candidates who are in service.

OR

- (c) Bachelor's Degree in Social Sciences as stated in (b) above or Home Science/ Nursing/ Education or Public Health from a recognized University, with at least three years experience in community health and who are in service.

5. Reservation for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) and Physically Handicapped category candidates:-

Fifteen percent (15%) seats are reserved for candidates belonging to SC, seven & half percent (7½%) seats for ST candidates and twenty seven (27%) seats for OBC candidates. It will be implemented as per 200 point Roster. The manner in which the Roster would be implemented is as per methodology adopted by the PG admission Committee and approved by the University dated 25.04.2009.

In MDS course, reservation for SC/ST/OBC candidates would be as per 13 point Roster following the same methodology.

Three percent (3%) seats shall be reserved horizontally for the candidates belonging to the Physically Handicapped category.
