1st Round of counselling for admission to BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS 2018.

A. Seat allotment in 1st round of Counselling: There will be seat allotment in the 1st round of counselling strictly according to merit/marks of NEET UG 2018.

Bulletin of Information 2018 states "The admission would be made strictly on merit on the basis of percentile of the eligible candidates in each category, determined by rank/ marks obtained in the NEET-UG -2018."

Eligibility Conditions/Requirement for admission to to BAMS/BUMS and BHMS Courses under 85% Delhi quota (As per Bulletin of Information 2018):-

(a) Age:The candidates should have completed the age of 17 (seventeen) years on or before 31st December 2018. The candidates completing the age of 17 years on 1st January 2019 or later will not be eligible for admission. The upper age limit is 25 years as on 31st December, 2018. Further provided that this upper age limit shall be relaxed by a period of 5 (five) years for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes.

(b) Qualifying examination:

(i) Indian Nationals/Overseas Citizen of India who have passed 12th class examination under 10+2 system conducted by the C.B.S.E/ Council of the Indian School Certificate Examination/ JamiaMilialslamia, New Delhi with required subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English from the recognized schools conducting regular classes situated within the National Capital Territory of Delhi only, will be eligible for admission. The candidates who have studied 11th and 12th standard through regular classes from a recognized school within the National Capital Territory of Delhi,

only are eligible to apply. Further the candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English separately and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category candidates) taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology".

- (ii) The candidates must have passed the qualifying examination, in all the required subjects separately (Theory and Practical), for admission to **BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS** Courses.
- (iii) A candidate who had not taken any one or more of the required subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in the qualifying examination but had subsequently passed in these subject(s) later as an additional subject is not eligible.
- (iv) The Candidates who have passed qualifying examination from PatracharVidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in MBBS/BDS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination Center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCTD) and they must upload a certificate from the controlling authority of PatracharVidyalaya/NIOS in this regard.
- (v) Candidates who have appeared in the Annual Examination of the year 2018 and are placed under compartment will not be eligible.
- (vi) Candidates who have appeared in the Annual Examination of the year 2018 and are reappearing for improvement will also not be considered eligible

Entrance Examination:In order to be eligible for admission to BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS courses for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to qualify the NEET-2018 exam and to obtain minimum of marks 50th percentile in National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET-2018) conducted by CBSE for admission to BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS courses held for the academic year-2018. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled caste (SC), Scheduled tribe (ST), Other backward classes (OBC), the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for UR-PwD and 40th percentile for SC-PwD, ST-PwD& OBC-PwD candidates.

The candidates who do not qualify the NEET-UG-2018 Examination conducted by CBSE are not eligible.

B. Fee to be paid online after allotment of seat: Only those candidates who are allotted seats in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi, after successful allotment of seats by University of Delhi are required to register themselves for admission online at Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi website www.fmsc.ac.in online link - Application for admission to BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS for 85% Delhi Quota.

They are required to complete the Registration by uploading their documents, photograph, signatures and the online payment of registration Fees.

C. Original Documents with two set of Self attested Photocopies to carry: As per Bulletin of Information, Candidates appearing in 1st round of counseling and offered admission in such Round, candidate must carry their original certificates in person and No extension of time for joining will be granted.

The candidates are required to bring following documents in Original as well as two sets of photocopies (self attested) (As specified in Bulletin of Information 2018):-

- (ii) NEET-UG-2018 Admit Card.
- (iii) NEET-UG-2018 Score Card.

- (vi) 10+2 Marksheet
- (vii) 10+2 Certificate
- (viii) Certificate from the Principal of the School on prescribed proforma available at faculty website: www.fmsc.ac.in stating that (i) the school is situated within National Capital Territory of Delhi, (ii) the school is recognized by the CBSE/Council for the Indian School Certificate/ JamiaMilialslamia/PatracharVidyalya/ National Institute of Open Schooling(NIOS), (iii) the school is conducting regular classes, (iv) the applicant has attended regular classes in the school for class (standard)11th & 12th.
 - (ix) The Candidates who have passed qualifying examination from PatracharVidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in BAMS/ BUMS and BHMS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination Center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCTD) and they must submit a certificate from the controlling authority of PatracharVidyalaya/NIOS in this regard
 - (x) Character Certificate in proforma as prescribed by CBSE, issued by the Principal of the school last attended or any Gazetted Officer.
 - (xi) Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe certificate, if applicable.
- (xii) Father's SC/ST Certificate, if applicable.
- (xiii) Person with Disability (Pwd) certificate, if applicable.
- (xiv) Entitlement Certificate for C.W. category.
- (xv) OBC Certificate, if applicable.
- (xvi) Non-Creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2017-2018, issued after 31st March, 2018 and OBC caste certificate as per the Central list for OBC's
- (xvii) Self-attested copy of OCI card, if applicable.
