Stray Vacancy Round of counselling for admission to MBBS 2018.

A. Seat allotment in Stray vacancy round of Counselling: There will be seat allotment in the Stray vacancy round of counselling strictly according to merit/marks of NEET UG 2018.

Clause 6 (c) of Bulletin of Information 2018 states "The admission would be made strictly on merit on the basis of percentile of the eligible candidates in each category, determined by rank/ marks obtained in the NEET-UG -2018."

B. Eligibility for Stray vacancy round of counselling and tentative vacancy position: List of eligible candidates which was provided by Medical Counseling Committee, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India for Stray vacancy round of counselling and tentative vacancy position for Stray vacancy round of counselling will be available on faculty website www.fmsc.ac.in. In this regard, candidates are advised to check regularly website of Medical Counseling Committee, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India (www.mcc.nic.in) and website of Faculty of Medical Sciences www.fmsc.ac.in.

Eligibility Conditions/Requirement for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses under 85% Delhi quota (As per Bulletin of Information 2018):-

(a) Age: The candidates should have completed the age of 17 (seventeen) years on or before 31st December 2018. The candidates completing the age of 17 years on 1st January 2019 or later will not be eligible for admission. The upper age limit is 25 years as on 31st December, 2018. Further provided that this upper age limit shall be relaxed by a period of 5 (five) years for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes.

(b) Qualifying examination:

(i) Indian Nationals/Overseas Citizen of India who have passed 12th class examination under 10+2 system conducted by the C.B.S.E/ Council of the Indian School Certificate Examination/ Jamia Milia Islamia, New Delhi with required subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English from the recognized schools conducting regular classes situated within the National Capital Territory of Delhi only, will be eligible for admission. The candidates who have studied 11th and 12th standard through regular classes from a recognized

school within the National Capital Territory of Delhi. Only are eligible to apply. Further the candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English separately and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category candidates) taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology".

In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum of 45% for Gen-PWD and 40% marks for SC- PWD /ST- PWD /OBC- PWD are required. Provided that a candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination the result of which has not been declared, he may be provisionally permitted to take up the competitive entrance examination and in case of selection for admission to the MBBS Course, he shall not be admitted to that course until he fulfills the eligibility criteria.

- (ii) The candidates must have passed the qualifying examination, in all the required subjects separately (Theory and Practical), for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses.
- (iii) A candidate who had not taken any one or more of the required subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in the qualifying examination but had subsequently passed in these subject(s) later as an additional subject is not eligible.
- (iv) The Candidates who have passed qualifying examination from Patrachar Vidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in MBBS/BDS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination Center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCTD) and they must upload a certificate from the controlling authority of Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS in this regard.
- (v) Candidates who have appeared in the Annual Examination of the year 2018 and are placed under compartment will not be eligible.
- (vi) Candidates who have appeared in the Annual Examination of the year 2018 and are reappearing for improvement will also not be considered eligible.

Entrance Examination: In order to be eligible for admission to MBBS/BDS courses for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to qualify the NEET-2018 exam and to obtain minimum of marks 50th percentile in National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET-2018) conducted by CBSE for admission to MBBS/BDS courses held for the academic year-2018. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled caste (SC), Scheduled tribe (ST), Other backward classes (OBC), the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for UR-PwD and 40th percentile for SC-PwD, ST-PwD & OBC-PwD candidates.

The candidates who do not qualify the NEET-UG-2018 Examination conducted by CBSE are not eligible.

C. Fee to be paid online after allotment of seat: Only those candidates who are allotted seats in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi, after successful allotment of seats by University of Delhi are required to register themselves for admission

online at Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi website www.fmsc.ac.in online link - Application for admission to MBBS/BDS for 85% Delhi Quota. They are required to complete the Registration by uploading their documents, photograph, signatures and the online payment of registration Fees.

- D. **Surety Bond**: All the candidates who are eligible for Stray Vacancy round of Counselling have to submit Fresh Surety Bond of Rs. 3 Lakh. (Specimen available at faculty website www.fmsc.ac.in).
- E. Original Documents with two set of Self attested Photocopies to carry: As per page 14 of Bulletin of Information, Candidates appearing in last round/mopup round of counseling and offered admission in such Last Round candidate must carry their original certificates in person and they will have No Right to surrender their seats once accepted and NO extension of time for joining will be granted.

The candidates are required to bring following documents in Original as well as two sets of photocopies (self attested) (As specified in Bulletin of Information 2018):-

- (viii) Certificate from the Principal of the School on prescribed proforma available at faculty website: www.fmsc.ac.in stating that (i) the school is situated within National Capital Territory of Delhi, (ii) the school is recognized by the CBSE/Council for the Indian School Certificate/ Jamia Milia Islamia/Patrachar Vidyalya/National Institute of Open Schooling(NIOS), (iii) the school is conducting regular classes, (iv) the applicant has attended regular classes in the school for class (standard) 11th & 12th.
 - (ix) The Candidates who have passed qualifying examination from Patrachar Vidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in MBBS/BDS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination Center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCTD) and they must submit a certificate from the controlling authority of Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS in this regard
 - (x) Character Certificate in proforma as prescribed by CBSE, issued by the Principal of the school last attended or any Gazetted Officer.
- (xi) Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe certificate, if applicable.
- (xii) Father's SC/ST Certificate, if applicable.
- (xiii) Person with Disability (Pwd) certificate, if applicable.
- (xiv) Entitlement Certificate for C.W. category.
- (xv) OBC Certificate, if applicable.

- (xvi) Non-Creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2017-2018, issued after 31st March, 2018 and OBC caste certificate as per the Central list for OBC's
- (xvii) Self-attested copy of OCI card, if applicable.

The candidates are requested to keep softcopy of above mentioned documents with themselves.

- F. Last Date of Joining of Candidates: As per revised time schedule for completion of the admission process for first mbbs course for the academic year 2018-19 dated 03.08.2018 received from Office of the ADG (ME), Medical Counselling Committee, Directorate General of Health Services, Minsitry of Health and Family Welfare, the last date of joining of candidates at allotted institute/college is 31st August 2018 (Friday) till 5.00 pm. In no case, the extension of the joining time will be considered.
